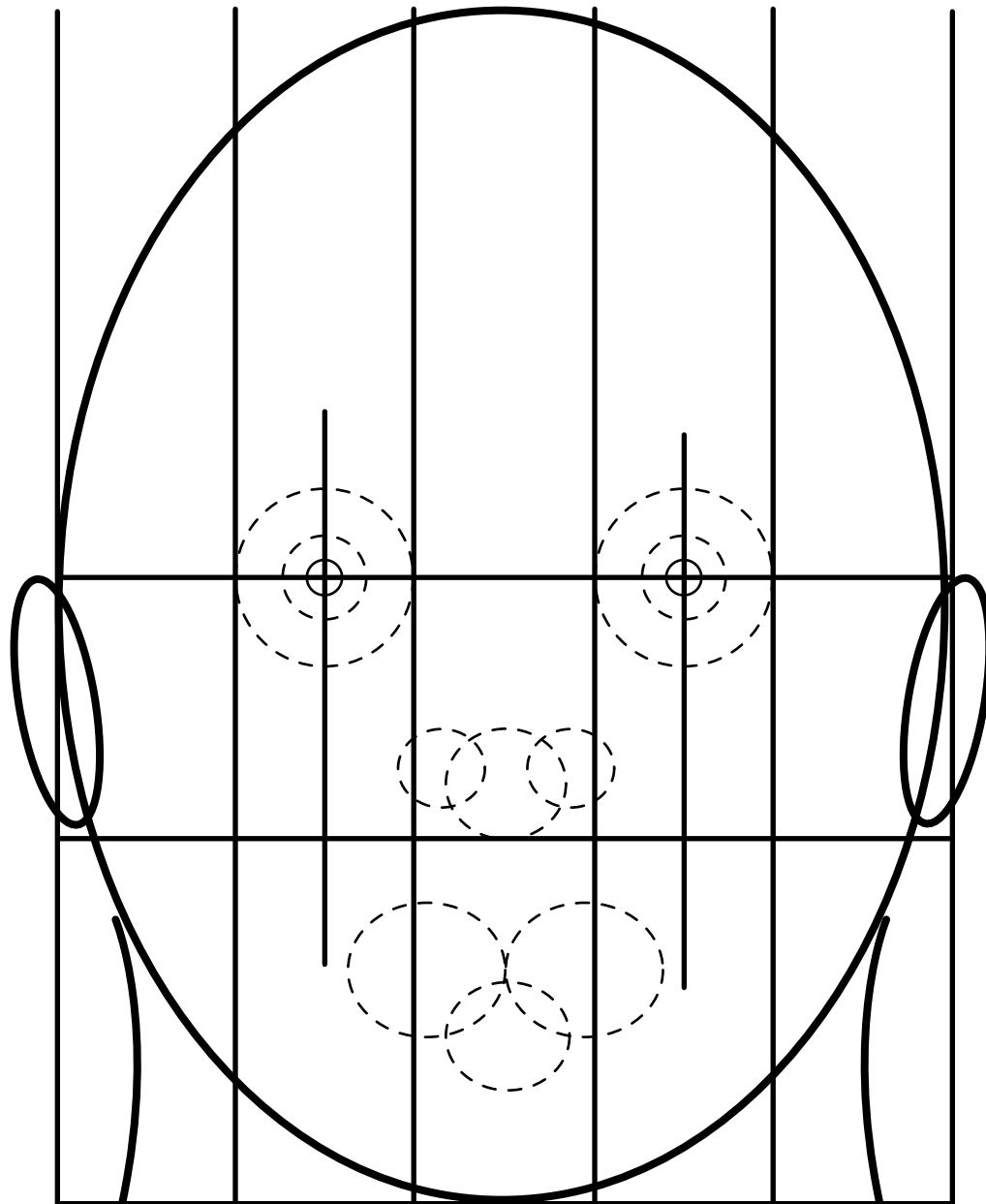


'SELFIES'

The Old-Fashioned Way



Use the above rough grid to help your students get the placement and proportions for the head and its features. Enlarge the above picture to fit onto 8½" x 11" copy paper, then have them practice drawing heads by having them either look at a classmate across the table or use head-on shots of people in magazines as reference. The eye, nose, and lips drawing instructions can be found on eTriarco.com. The neck lines differ from person to person depending on the thickness and length of the neck. Once your students have had time to practice this exercise, give them a mirror and have them work on a self-portrait. Emphasize capturing the details that make them look like the individual that they are.
